**WEST NYACK, N.Y. (October 2020):** United Way of Rockland will kick-off their 27th Annual Fall Day of Caring event on Monday, October 5. Celebrated as the largest community service event in Rockland County, Fall Day of Caring mobilizes a collective force for good with the United Way as its backbone. This year, Fall Day of Caring has been reimagined as a 10-day event, from October 5-16, offering participants flexible, socially distant and creative volunteer opportunities. They will also be assembling United Way Senior Activity Kits over the two-week period that will be distributed to homebound seniors who are isolated and need engagement, as well as seniors in local nursing home facilities.
